

Minutes: ASME Research & Technology Committee on Water and Steam in Thermal Systems, Main Committee

IWC, Orlando, FL 10/24/07

A. Harvey, committee chairman opened the meeting.

The minutes of the spring 2007 meeting were accepted.

A. Banweg presented the financial report. Respective balances for the Main Committee and Properties Committee are \$55,455.43 and \$42,304.18.

D. Daniels reported on the Amine project progress. We have received a proposal from Digby McDonald for corrosion potential and electrochemistry work on 471NiCrMo, a turbine rotor material. Initial testing will be done using ellipsometry using ammonia as the pH treatment chemistry; future testing then will use monoethanolamine as the pH treatment.

T. Beardwood reported that there were 66 attendees at the ASME sponsored session.

R. Light reported on the Water Technology Subcommittee meeting where the subcommittee's current projects, the HRSG guidelines and the Pre-commissioning document were the topics of discussion (minute posted separately).

J. Bellows reported on the activities of the Properties Committee (minutes posted separately). This meeting was actually held at the Siemens Orlando facility.

The committee discussed possible topics for the IWC ASME session. IWC will be held in San Antonio in 2008.
